Current buildings <u>are</u> important for many at 8am, 9am Heritage (BCP), 10am Classic & 6.30pm.

Particular location and timing are <u>less</u> important to most at Busbridge Contemporary. Live streaming is acceptable but preference is to livestream to a public building, not to homes.

BCP online averages 87 worshippers. One BCP worshipper is in Wales. Most BCP worshippers will return to the building "in a while" but not yet. Several BCPers would like BCP live-streamed.

**Current buildings are important** for **8am, BCP, Classic** & **6.30**. We are adapting the church buildings to allow this to happen. Work has started on installing live-streaming technology, loudspeakers and connections to other rooms and buildings for overflow for numbers. We are trying various approaches over the next few weeks.

We can get a good number into buildings with good social distancing.

Classic and BCP are likely to be back in the church buildings in September.

We are looking at the Busbridge **6.30** and **8am**. Multiple use of a single building on a single day requires deep cleaning and poses questions. **8am** and **6.30** people may wish to consider similar 'style' worship (Classic and Contemporary) in the meantime.

Dudley Hilton is stepping aside as **6:30** leader and it is a time to talk to the congregation about the shape of this service. Thank you to Dudley for your years of leadership.
